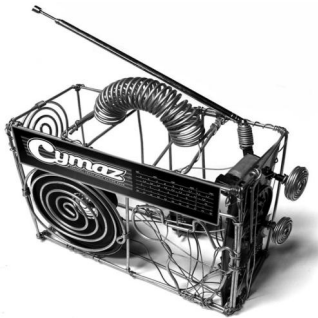
Developing CYMAZ Internet Radio Station (a radio station run by and for young people)

CYMAZ Radio Hub news!! As part of the pilot, training courses for young people are well underway in The House, St Austell and Livewire Youth Music Project, Saltash. More than 40 young people are taking part in the 12 week course. They are planning their own shows including making jingles, creating idents for the station and interviewing bands. One team is making a programme about a metal single produced at Livewire to raise money to build a school in Haiti!! 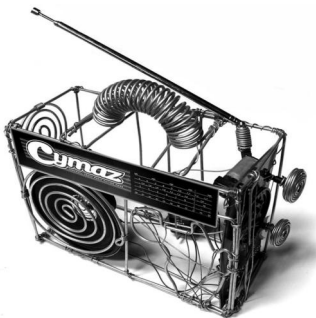
