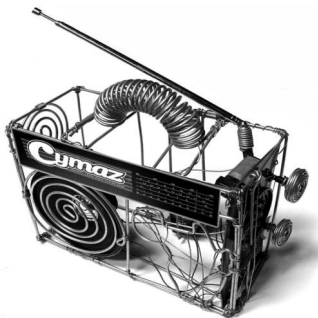
Developing CYMAZ Internet Radio Station – run by and for young people

**A date for your diary: CYMAZ Official Radio Launch
3rd November 2010 - Check our website / Facebook for updates.**

- Tune into **CYMAZ Radio** and listen to the work produced from our first 3 CYMAZ Radio Hubs at Livewire (Saltash), the House (St Austell) and Humphry Davy School (Penzance). Young teams of presenters, producers and researchers are developing creating their own shows.
- **20 CYMAZ Radio Podcasts** available to listen to and download and we haven't properly launched yet!! They can be accessed via our website www.cymaz.co.uk or our Facebook group 'CYMAZ Radio'.
- **80 Teachers from Humphry Davy School have been trained by CYMAZ.** Creating audio content has become embedded into the whole curriculum! Teachers have been asked to create and produce audio content every month with young people in their lessons. Check website for our latest podcasts.
- **6 new CYMAZ Radio Hubs** will commence in October / November 2010. If you/your organisation want to find out what to do to become a hub contact the CYMAZ Office
- **Recruitment.** With so much demand for the work, we have recruited a team of Radio Trainers to help us to deliver our training package to our new Radio Hubs coming on board this autumn!
- Volunteer Cornwall and CYMAZ are working in partnership with Social Services. Volunteer Cornwall was successful in a bid to the Community Grant programme to set up **CYMAZ Radio Hubs in three Learning Disabilities Centres for Vulnerable Young Adults** around Cornwall.
- We are delighted that new CYMAZ Radio Hubs are being set up in Illogan Youth Centre, Helston Youth Centre and The Foyer, Truro.
- CYMAZ Radio was featured on The Source FM following an extremely successful time at Port Eliot Festival. Managing the Green Room for the Twenty Five Tent, CYMAZ collected audio content throughout the festival. Our own Moss (Steve Cantrill) CYMAZ Radio Station Manager was interviewed live on air! Delivering music activity across the county including mobile provision to isolated, rural communities

- **DCMS Rehearsal Spaces for Young People.** We have finally got all the musical instruments and equipment in place now for the mobile resources. Work will commence in October 2010.
- Negotiations have taken place with Locality workers from Youth Cornwall and **CYMAZ has secured money from the** Positive Activities for Young People to match the YMAZ programme money.
- **More Recruitment.** CYMAZ has just recruited some new music leaders to help us deliver music activity across the county. The mobile provision brought into the county from the DCMS Rehearsal Spaces programme will enable young people in isolated communities to access music making and be supported to continue with the help of local volunteers.
- The **mobile resource kits** will be housed in the Dracaena Centre in Falmouth and at Livewire Youth Music Project in Saltash from where they will be transported to community settings, providing activity based on the interests and needs of each group.
- **CYMAZ continues to support work** at Helston Youth Centre, Newquay Youth Centre, Fourways Youth Centre (St Blazey), The House (St Austell), Livewire (Saltash), The Lizard (Young Musician Centres supported by MADE), The Clays (delivered by Kernow Voice, Hall for Cornwall), Young People Cornwall youth projects across Cornwall.

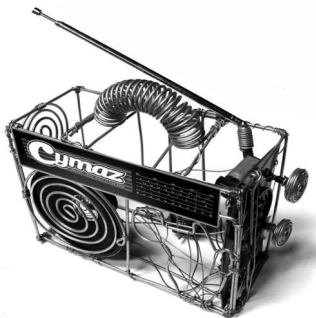
Coordinating a range of performance platforms for young people in partnership with other agencies/venues

- Auditions took place in Redruth on 9th October for **Splanna!** a new performance piece created by talented young people. **Splanna! will premiere at Hall for Cornwall on 30th November 2010.** CYMAZ is working with Rogue Theatre and a team of creative professionals to facilitate the devising process with the company of young people.
- CYMAZ worked with Rogue Theatre at the **Port Eliot Festival** at the end of July, managing the Green Room for performers. It was a space for the young performers to relax, network and be interviewed for CYMAZ Radio. The CYMAZ Green Room proved so popular that it was requested again as a service at **Kernow Live!** on 6th August in Boscawen Park, Truro and at **Youth Fest** at The House on 25th August. Young performers, some of whom have progressed their music through attending CYMAZ activities over the years, were really pleased to have opportunities to perform.

Developing a range of services to ensure the sustainability of CYMAZ

- CYMAZ has been developing a range of **radio training packages**. Different levels of training can be purchased, from one off sessions to 12 week programmes. Projects and agencies already generating audio content can pay a small fee to submit their shows to CYMAZ for CYMAZ Radio.
- **CYMAZ Audio Productions** is our trading arm, through which CYMAZ can be commissioned to make audio productions suited to the needs of the commissioner. CYMAZ was commissioned by **Youth Music** in July to create a podcast about a national celebration event for a volunteering programme.
- Audio productions can be made for broadcast on **CYMAZ Radio** (subject to passing our guidelines and moderation process) or can be created for other use. Audio recordings are an excellent way to carry out evaluations and provide a cost effective and lasting memory of a moment, event or project.
- Music workshops have recently been commissioned by Eden as part of the **Xpress 10** Relays Cultural Olympiad project, the **Saturday Club** in Truro (led by the Police) and the **Dracaena Centre** in Falmouth (Positive Activities for Young People funding).
- CYMAZ is working in partnership with **KEAP** (Kernow Education Arts Partnership) to project manage and deliver a media project for disadvantaged young people. Funded through a **Big Mediabox** grant, the **Scene & Heard** project aims to support young people to obtain bursary money to create their own media product. Our very own CYMAZ Radio Station Manager, Moss, is working alongside two other media professionals; a cartoonist who draws for the Beano and the Dandy and a professional photographer. These media professionals are supporting and guiding the young people to create cartoons, photographs and podcasts to tell a story or raise an issue important to them. In phase one of the project we are working in **Liskeard Short Stay School** and **The House Youth Centre** in St Austell.

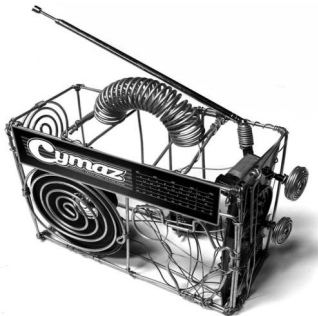
CYMAZ on the Web
