The National Youth Jazz Collective is delighted to launch its National Youth Jazz Summer School 2011, which will be held at the University of East Anglia from 3pm 14th August - 11am 21st August 2011, culminating in a free public performance given by the summer school participants at 6pm on 20th August and a pre-concert seminar at 4.30pm for aspiring young jazz musicians looking for advice on "Good practice for young jazz musicians".

This week-long summer school, funded by Youth Music, will bring together 30 of England's most gifted and talented young jazz musicians (aged 14 to 18) to work with a team of highly experienced jazz educators, who are also internationally renowned jazz artists. Tutors for 2011 summer school include NYJC's Founder and Artistic Director Issie Barratt, Nic France, Nikki Iles, Mark Lockheart, Liam Noble, Jeremy Price, Nick Smart, Martin Speake and Mike Walker.

The focus of the National Youth Jazz Summer School is to develop improvisatory and interactive skills within the context of small group playing, as well as offering a high level of performance experience and professional guidance.
